WHAT IS EUROPACT

EUROPACT was founded in 2006 and is a triannual pan-European conference on Process Analytics and Control Technology. The conference covers new technologies in process analytics and process performance monitoring, and the implementation of these technologies in various technological fields, including the transformation of data into knowledge, and industrial sectors.

EUROPACT is organised by industrial and professional organisations interested in advances in process analysis and process control for manufacturing industries.

The scope of industrial coverage is broad including the chemical, pharmaceutical, biotechnology, food, healthcare and electronics industries, as well as technology solution providers.

EuroPACT's strategic vision is to build partnerships with European key players by inviting national and sectoral organisations into the EuroPACT consortium to encourage the pan-European and pan-sectoral development of process analytics and control technologies.

EuroPACT 2008 was held in Frankfurt, Germany and EuroPACT 2011 will take place in Glasgow, Scotland, UK. The intention is to move the conference to different European cities every three years.

DECHEMA provides the core administration and organisational support for EUROPACT and works with a local committee formed by the hosting organisation for each EUROPACT conference.

In addition to the presentation of invited and contributed lectures, EUROPACT features poster presentations and an exhibition. Pre-conference courses are also organised.

EUROPACT aspires to minimise the cost of participation in the conference and encourages the involvement of younger workers in the field of process analytics and control technologies. Conference fees are kept low through sponsorship and the exhibition fees paid by companies. Any profits that are made from a EUROPACT conference are distributed 30% to DECHEMA, 30% towards the next EUROPACT conference and 40% to the local organising group.
